These were the possible ideas for this years grant application:

Doggy boxes- to be placed around Palisades where residents walk their dogs. Signs to be used by the PNA to advertise meetings, picnics and other events. NEP- more natural gas shut-off wrenches.

Website calendar: This will be addressed in the coming months as we finish the picnic and Ask the Candidate event.

Logo update- Project completed.

Greentree pool sign: This project is complete with fliers in the box for residents to take. The cost was \$49 for the sign, \$13 for the flier box and \$18 for printing 120 fliers. Total cost was \$80.

October general meeting: Do we want any guest speakers? Rick will contact Friends of Tryon Creek to talk about a backyard habitat program and the American Lung Association to talk about educating the community about Radon. The Lakeridge rotunda was the recommended location for this meeting.

PNA picnic and fundraiser- scheduled for September 9<sup>th</sup> from 2-5pm at Lakeridge HS. The picnic area has been reserved and a \$80 fee paid for custodial support and bathrooms. The NEP committee will handle the fire department, police and a backpack demonstration table. The Executive team and volunteers will handle area maps, email sign-up, money collections

and signage. Advertising will be through Hello LO, PNA signs, The Oregonian, LO Review, website, email blast, Thriftway and a mailed out postcard. Other volunteers will be needed for food related duties. We will be charging \$5.00 for hot dogs, chips, fruit and a drink.

LO candidates declare from 8/8 to 8/25. Three candidates have filed their petitions as of August 13<sup>th</sup> and a letter has been written to invite these candidates.
