Welcome to audience and candidates. (Rick) Thanks for taking time from your busy schedules to attend the Palisades Neighborhood Candidate Forum. I'm going to walk you through the rules and expectations of tonight's event. We placed a notecard and pen on your chair and here's what we want from you. Please write down a general question for the candidates to answer, avoid being candidate specific, as the question will be answered by more than one candidate. At the bottom of the card, please write your first name. If your card is picked to be read, you have the opportunity to stand and have the candidates answer your question directly. All the cards with questions will be picked up in the next 15 minutes to avoid interrupting the candidates question and answer session.

Here's the way the forum will run:

The candidates will have 2 minutes each to introduce themselves to the audience. Following that, each candidate will draw one question from a fishbowl that contains questions from the Palisades Board. These are general questions and an icebreaker to get the candidates warmed up. After completing this round, we will start asking questions from the audience. Each audience question will be answered by two candidates in order.
